- 7) Address follow-up questions



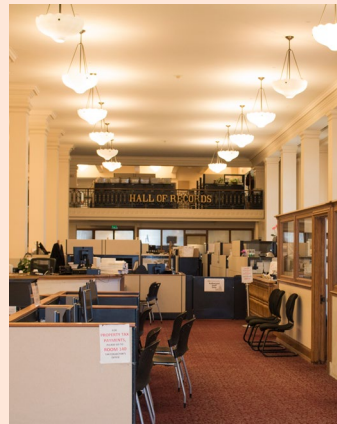
This partnership regularly works on major data projects utilizing local, state, and federal government data sources.

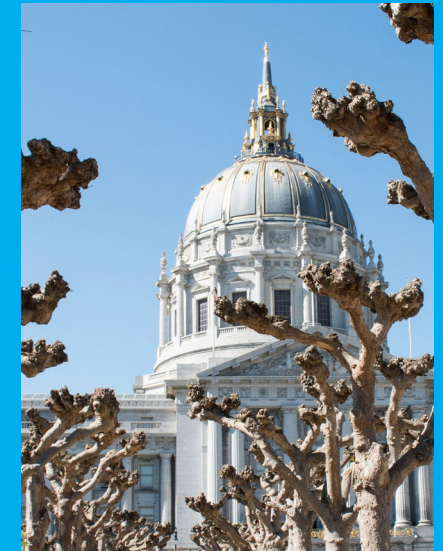
